

RodiCare® Vita C

Feed supplement for guinea pigs and small rodents

Contains vitamin C



RodiCare® Vita C supplements the diet with vitamin C. Unlike other mammals, guinea pigs are not able to synthesise vitamin C themselves. A vitamin C deficiency can occur with an unbalanced diet. However, infections, digestive disorders, stress and strain can also result in an increased requirement in guinea pigs and small rodents. Excess vitamin C is excreted via the kidneys.



Composition:

Dried and ground carrots, parsley grass meal, cellulose, maltodextrin, magnesium stearate.

Crude fat 3.5%

Feeding recommendation:

To be given with food or as a treat.

Half a tablet to one tablet per guinea pig once a day.

One tablet contains approx. 40 mg vitamin C.

The required feeding quantity can vary depending on the pet's species, weight, age and health. The exact quantity should be agreed after consultation with a vet.

Notes:

The tablets are available in carrot and parsley flavours, therefore come in different colours.

Store away from light and not above 25°C.
