Complete feed for dwarf rabbits, guinea pigs, degus and chinchillas

A high content of crude fibre from Alpine grass meal, soya bean hulls and oat bran supports the maintenance of the gut flora and promotes intestinal peristalsis.

Pectins and fructo-oligosaccharides (FOS) selectively encourage beneficial gut flora in the caecum and colon (prebiotics).

Vitamins and minerals help prevent diet- and illness-related deficiencies.

Fenugreek seeds, calamus root and turmeric stimulate appetite and digestive activity.

Chamomile flowers, peppermint, fennel, caraway and liquorice enrich the diet with valuable secondary plant compounds.

RodiCare® instant is a premium, high-fibre, low-calcium complete feed in powder form for dwarf rabbits, guinea pigs, chinchillas and degus that are temporarily unable to eat solid food on their own. **RodiCare® instant** can also be used as a base diet for other small rodents with reduced appetite, herbivorous reptiles and birds, but must then be supplemented to meet the needs of the species in question.

RodiCare® instant is also suitable as a rearing feed for orphaned young animals, as well as for supplementary feeding of weak or failing youngsters that are no longer reliant solely on milk.

RodiCare® instant contains all essential vitamins and minerals. Thanks to its high vitamin C content, it also ensures an adequate supply for guinea pigs that are temporarily not receiving fresh food.

A high proportion of crude fibre supports healthy digestive activity. In addition, **RodiCare® instant** contains a specially balanced herbal blend that aids digestion and helps stimulate appetite.

Alpine grass meal 30%, soya bean hulls 25%, linseed cake, oat bran 10%, wheat germ, fennel seed 1.5%, rapeseed oil, mint 1%, caraway seed 1%, pectin 1%, sodium chloride, fenugreek seed 0.5%, liquorice 0.5%, turmeric 0.5%, calamus root 0.5%, dried chamomile flowers 0.5%, fructo-oligosaccharides 0.25%

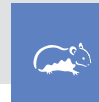
Feeding recommendation:

Mix the powder with warm water at roughly a 1:2 ratio (1 part powder to 2 parts water) until it forms a smooth, spoonable mash. If needed, it can be made a little thinner or thicker. Unless otherwise agreed with your vet, feed at least 60–80 ml of the prepared mash per kg bodyweight per day, divided into 5 to 6 meals.

Very weak animals should be fed as often as possible (every 2–3 hours) in small portions.

Depending on the species, weight, age and condition of the animal, the required amount and feeding frequency may vary and should therefore be agreed with your vet.

Offer the mash in a bowl or on a small spoon. If the animal does not eat voluntarily, **RodiCare® instant** is carefully administered in small amounts into the side of the mouth using a syringe.



During the transition from liquid to solid food, **RodiCare® instant** can be mixed with a little water and shaped into small dough-like lumps for feeding. As soon as the animal is eating solid food again, the **RodiCare® instant** ration should be reduced accordingly.

Store the mash in a cool place and use within 12 hours. Do not feed the mash cold.

Notes:

In addition, good-quality hay and fresh water should always be available freely.

As full recovery of the digestive tract can take several weeks, it is advisable to feed RodiCare® basic pellets during and after the transition to solid food.

Store in a dry place below 25 °C!
